WE COMMAND YOU, that all business and excuses being laid aside to appear in person before the Higher Education Committee of the Senate of the State of New York, at the Roosevelt Hall Little Theater, Farmingdale State University, Farmingdale, New York on the fourteenth day of July, 2006, at twelve o'clock in the afternoon date thereof, to testify and give evidence as a witness in a certain matter now pending in the investigation of all standardized testing in the state of New York (Hearing Notice Attached).

You are further commanded to bring with you and produce at the time and place aforesaid, all documents pertaining to the SAT examination, including the comprehensive review of the testing errors from the October 2005 SAT exams prepared by the consulting firm Booz, Allen and Hamilton, any additional documents relating the process of scoring the SAT now in your custody and control and all other writings which you have in your custody concerning the above premises.

This request shall include, but not limited to, any and all computer-generated information, handwritten or typewritten documentation and all files, documents and correspondence pursuant to Sections 341 and 342 of the Education Law.

FAILURE TO COMPLY with this subpoena and subpoena duces tecum is punishable as a contempt of court and shall make you liable to the person(s) on whose behalf this was issued for a penalty.
